

5th - Core Concepts – Q3

Study Sheet

- New symbol: (*pg. 8*)
 - fermata – hold a note or rest longer than normal

- Tempo markings: (*pg. 11*)
 - tempo is the speed of the BEAT
 - usually written above the staff, at the beginning
 - Allegro – brisk tempo (fast)
 - Andante – medium-slow walking tempo
 - Moderato – medium tempo

- New Dynamics: (*pg. 11*)
 - Volume markings are dynamics
 - Crescendo – gradually get louder
 - Decrescendo – gradually get softer

- Ties: (*pg. 14*)
 - a curved line that connects 2 or more notes of the same pitch
 - play one note for the combined counts (add them together)

- Dotted notes/rests: (*pg. 14*)
 - a dot adds half of the value of the original note/rest
 - Example: $\text{♩} \cdot = 2+1$
