<u>6th grade - Core Concepts – Q1</u> <u>Study Sheet</u>

- Vocabulary/symbols:
 - \circ Articulation tonguing at the start of each pitch
 - Beat steady pulse
 - Rhythm pattern of sounds and silences
 - \circ Staff 5 lines and 4 spaces on which music is written
 - Clef treble (high) or bass (low); BE ABLE TO DRAW IT
 - Key signature between the clef and the time sig.; indicates which pitches are flat/sharp and remains in effect for the entire composition
 - Time signature top number tells how many beats per measure
 - Bar line divides the beats into groups (measures)
 - Measure group of beats; the space between 2 bar lines
- Rhythms:
 - \circ Quarter note/rest = 1 count
 - \circ Half note/rest = 2 counts
 - \circ Whole note/rest = 4 counts
 - DOTTED : original plus half of the original
 - Ties curved line, connecting notes of the same pitch (ADD them and play for the combined counts)
